



CODE OF CONDUCT

Centers for Spiritual Living Teen Camp is dedicated to being a compassionate, inclusive spiritual community empowering each other and the world to thrive. Being mindful of that, this is our code of conduct:

- Attendance & participation is required at all activities.
- All youth will remain within designated camp boundaries.
- Bed check hour shall be observed by all.
- Visitation of dorms/tents other than that of the camper's selected cabin at time of registration is prohibited.
- Cell phone use at camp is permitted, providing it does not interfere with camp activities.
- Respect shall be shown for all public and private property.
- Ground rules of the host camp shall be observed.
- Clothing must comply with camp's regulations and CSL dress code. (See dress code)
- No alcohol, drugs, medical marijuana, nicotine, e-cigarettes, vapor products, weapons or fireworks are permitted
- No sexual activity of any kind (including kissing) is allowed at any time during this event.
- Harassment of any kind, including unwelcome physical or verbal threats or sexual conduct, is not permitted.
- Physical abuse is not permitted.
- All defamatory, abusive, profane, pornographic,-and/or illegal materials are not permitted.

***Failure to comply with these agreements will result in consequences that could include being removed from the camp and being prohibited from future CSL Teen Events. ***
