

Request for Proposals to Facilitate a Workshop During SOAR Retreat 2025

Duration: 90 Minutes

Create Workshops with interaction among the attendees.

Each workshop should include at least three (3) takeaways for the attendees experiencing the session.

Our workshop sessions are a vital component of the overall event schedule. They should be collaborative and inspiring and provide tools to support individuals in bringing their light into the world.

In keeping with our retreat theme, *A Journey of Revelation, Restoration, and Grace*, we are looking for submissions focused on the following areas:

- Revelation: Discovering spiritual truths or personal insight
- Restoration: Releasing Burdens, regaining equilibrium, or other restorative activities
- Rituals or spiritual practices that set the tone for a sacred, restorative, or reflective space
- Creative Expression: Singing, chanting, and/or other restorative activities

CSL Workshop Presenter Policies & Procedures

1. A workshop presenter must be a minister, a practitioner, or a member of a CSL Member Community or an approved affiliated work with Centers for Spiritual Living. The member must be in good standing with the organization and current with all applicable membership dues, fees, or licenses. CSL can remove the speaker and session from the program if the speaker is not in good standing.

2. Workshop presenters can attend the 2025 SOAR Retreat for only the day they are presenting and are not required to attend for the entire week of the retreat; such workshop presenters will not be required to pay a registration fee for the day they are speaking or facilitating.

3. Workshop presenters who pay a registration fee for the entire week of the 2025 SOAR Retreat will receive a \$100 discount on the registration fee for the day they are facilitating. There will be no further reimbursements or accommodations (e.g., travel, lodging, food, etc.).

4. Centers for Spiritual Living is an inclusive organization that honors diversity. Workshop presenters will be mindful of language choice and refrain from making any remarks that are disparaging or insulting to any group or individual. Racial, ethnic, or homophobic slurs, regardless of context, are considered inappropriate in all cases.

5. All workshop presenters agree that workshops **will not** contain a sales pitch for a product or a service.

6. Please submit all required information by March 10, 2025.

7. We have limited workshop spaces. **You will be notified by April 10, 2025, if your proposal is selected.**
