



As a kid, **Brett Palm** would sidle up to the big speakers in his parents' house in Southern California, listening to his father's favorite big band music. He was enraptured by the feel and groove of the bass. Brett spent his twenties on St. John in the Virgin Islands where he was known island-wide as "Bass Man," providing the foundation for bands in genres from jazz to Caribbean to rock 'n roll. Returning to the mainland, Brett wrote and recorded four albums with his jazz band, Planet B. Currently, he plays bass with Costa Rican bands, top 40 groups, and jazz combos.
